- Immigration status and how to identify NRPF cases
- Children Act provisions for families and care leavers
- Human rights assessment

#### 5. Migrant children in care

- Identifying children with immigration or EU status issues
- Local authority duty to support
- Framework for EU national, migrant and asylum-seeking children
